

Addendum to Grange School Whole School Food Policy During the Coronavirus Outbreak 2020

In line with the government guidance we will continue to provide all children with a meal if they are attending school. The children will be provided with a cold packed lunch which has been prepared by Mellors catering staff. If the numbers remain low catering teams may be joined and the lunches prepared at one school site within the MAT and transported to Grange. The school lunches will be distributed by a designated lunch time supervisor to each bubble of children

There is no requirement to continue to provide universal infant free school meals to infant pupils who are not in school.

We will continue to provide support for children eligible for benefits-related free school meals who are at home. These families will be supported by:

- Providing meals or food parcels through your food provider.
- Using the Department for Education's (DfE) centrally-funded national voucher scheme
- Providing alternative vouchers for a local shop or supermarket

Before eating the children will be supervised washing their hands one at a time to ensure compliance with the school risk assessment. To reduce the risk of spreading the virus the children will eat their lunch in their designated bubble group in a designated area, usually a classroom. There may be times when staff feel it is appropriate for the children to eat their lunch outside. Children will remain in their bubble group at all times with their designated staff members.
